HISTORY

In the summer of 2006, former Mayor Bobby Irons was encouraged to find a way to publically recognize residents of Florence and Lauderdale County who have achieved national or international fame. Several ideas on how to give notable recognition to these individuals were considered. Then, with the support and approval of the Florence City Council, a Selection Committee was appointed and commissioned to design and establish a Walk of Honor.
