Clint Herring will be at Kennedy-Douglass Center for the Arts on Thursday, March 25, to meet the many patrons who have expressed an interest in his work. There will be an informal reception and gallery walk-through from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. that evening. Herring will also be in the gallery at noon to give patrons another opportunity to talk to him about his work.

Herring's exhibit, *Only Water Divides: Southern Harmony*, includes twenty-one watercolor paintings that focus on the architecture and people of the South and of the Bahamas. The work remains on exhibit through March 25. Herring lives in Auburn, Alabama, and works primarily in the medium of transparent watercolor.

He attended Auburn University and worked as art director for a design firm before establishing himself as a full-time professional artist. His work has been exhibited in numerous galleries and museums across the South and was featured in the July 2004 issue of *The Artist's Magazine* and the April 2008 issue of *American Artist*.
